BYLAW NO. 2016-05

A BYLAW TO RESTRICT THE WEIGHTS OF VEHICLES ON ROADS

The Council of the Village of Aylesbury in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw "road" means any public highway within the municipality as defined in The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997, other than a Provincial Highway as designated to such Act.
- 2. "Vehicle" shall mean a vehicle, trailer or semi-trailer or a motor vehicle as ascribed to by The Traffic Safety Act.
- 3. Signs indicating the maximum vehicle weight allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the vehicle weight restriction zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the vehicle weight restriction zone area.
- 4. The maximum vehicle weight allowed on a particular road are as follows:
 - i) No person shall operate a vehicle at a greater weight than 8 tons on the following roads:
 - Main Street within the Village of Aylesbury
- 5. Any person who violates any provision of this Bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
- 6. Bylaw 2016-05 shall take effect upon approval of the bylaw by the Ministry of Transportation.
