

BYLAW NO.2023-06

A BYLAW FOR THE VILLAGE OF AYLESBURY TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Village of Aylesbury in the Province of Saskatchewan pursuant to Section 8 and sub section 12(1) of *The Municipalities Act* enacts as follows;

1. This Bylaw may be referred to as the *Speed Limit Bylaw*.
2. This Bylaw is intended to:
 - i) Identify areas within the Municipality where reduced speed is limited and;
 - ii) Set out penalties and/or fines for those persons who exceed the speed limits on public roadways.
3. In this Bylaw:
 - i) "Roadway" shall mean any public roadway within the Municipality under the direction, control, and management of the Municipality;
 - ii) "Motor Vehicle" shall mean a motor vehicle as defined by *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*; and
 - iii) "Municipality" shall mean the Village of Aylesbury.
4. Provisions of this Bylaw:
 - i) No persons shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than **30 km/hr** on a public roadway within the Municipality boundaries.
5. Enforcement of this Bylaw:
 - i) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a penalty of that identified in *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*.
 - ii) Enforcement of this Bylaw may be made by the RCMP and/or a Bylaw Enforcement Officer appointed for the enforcement of the Municipal Bylaws through resolution of Council.


This bylaw shall come into effect upon passing.
