BYLAW No. 2011-02

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED AND WEIGHT OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Craik No. 222, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act:
 - (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the Highway Traffic
- 2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 50 kilometers per hour nor will not exceed a weight of 3 tonnes on that portion of a public highway described as follows: the bridge located at ESE of Section 07, Township 21, Range 27 West of the 2nd Meridian. Signs indicating the maximum weight and speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
- 4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
