A BYLAW TO SET UP THE CRAIK AND DISTRICT RECREATION BOARD

The Council of in the Rural Municipality of Craik No. 222 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

I. The Rural Municipality of Craik No. 222 in the Province of Saskatchewan, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw and identified as Exhibit "A", with the following Municipalities;

(a) The Town of Craik.

### **DEFINITION**

- 1. In this bylaw, including this section:
  - (a) "board" means the recreation board appointed pursuant to this bylaw.
  - (b) "council" means the council of the Town of Craik and the Rural Municipality of Craik No. 222.
  - (c) "municipality" means the Town of Craik and the Rural Municipality of Craik No. 222.

## **FUNCTION**

2. To advise Council on projects to improve or extend any of the Recreation facilities.

### COMPOSITION OF BOARD

- 3. The Board shall consist of seven (7) members, to be appointed by resolution of the respective councils and include the following:
  - (a) Four (4) members of the Town of Craik.
  - (b) Three(3) members from the Rural Municipality of Craik No. 222
- 4. At the first appointment of the Board members, the term of office shall be two (2) years.
- 5. The seat of a member of the Board who absents himself from three consecutive meetings without previous authorization by resolution of the Board shall be declared vacant:
- 6. (a) A member of the Board may resign by delivering to the secretary a written notice of resignation.
  - (b) The seat shall become vacant upon receipt of the notice by the Secretary.
- 7. If a vacancy arises the Secretary shall, prior to the next meeting of Council, give Council a written notice of the vacancy.
- 8. The Council shall, by resolution at the first meeting following receipt of the notice of vacancy, fill the vacancy.
- 9. Four (4) members shall constitute a quorum.

### **MEETINGS**

- 10. The board shall meet at least once a month, at a time and place as set by resolution of the Board at the first meeting of the Board each year.
- 11. The Secretary shall, at the request of the Chairperson or one third of the members call a special meeting at a date specified in the request.
- 12. All members of the Board present shall vote gon each question.
- 13. The Chairperson shall preside at all meetings.
- 14. If the Chairperson should be unable to attend the meeting, the members present shall appoint a Chairperson from the members present.
- 15. All actions of the Board shall be entered in a minute book, to be kept for that purpose and signed by the Chiarperson and the Secretary.
- 16. Upon approval of the minutes, at the next regular meeting the Chairperson and the Secretary shall initial each page.
- 17. The secretary shall prepare and submit an annual report of all the activities af the Board to the last regular meeting of the Council for the year.
