BYLAW NO. 82-17

A BYLAW CONCERNING THE ERECTION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SIGNS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Craik No. 222 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. In this Bylaw the expression "road" means any public highway within the municipality as defined in the Highways Act, other than a Provincial Highway as designated pursuant to such Act.
- 2. Signs containing the word "stop" shall be erected at the intersection of roadways at the following locations:

- 7. Any person who violates any provision of this Bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
