

BYLAW NO. 94-10

A BYLAW TO PREVENT LOOSE WIRE LYING EXPOSED

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Craik No. 222 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The owner or occupant of any land or premises in the municipality shall promptly remove any loose wire lying thereon.
2. If any owner or occupant neglects or refuses to comply with the provisions of Section 1, the Secretary Treasurer may, by registered letter, require him to do so within fourteen days after the mailing of such letter, and at the expiration of that time may cause the loose wire to be removed, protected, or guarded at the expense of the person in default, and in the case of non-payment the amount expended may be recovered, with costs, by action or in like manner as municipal taxes.
