

BYLAW NO. 94-25

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE ENTRY UPON LAND FOR THE REMOVAL OF DRIFT SOIL

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Craik No. 222 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Council is hereby authorized to effect entry upon any land adjoining a road allowance or other public highway, wherever such entry is deemed to be necessary for the purpose of removing from such land any drifted soil which has accumulated along the boundary thereof.
2. The Council may also remove any boundary fence where its removal is deemed necessary for the purpose mentioned in Section 1 hereof; provided that any fence so removed shall be replaced forthwith after such purpose has been fulfilled.
3. Any person who obstructs or interferes with an agent or servant of the municipality engaged in carrying out the provisions of a resolution passed pursuant this bylaw, or who destroys, pulls down, alters or interferes with any works carried out or thing done under the authority of this bylaw and any such resolution, shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties prescribed by Section 175 of the Rural Municipality Act, 1989.

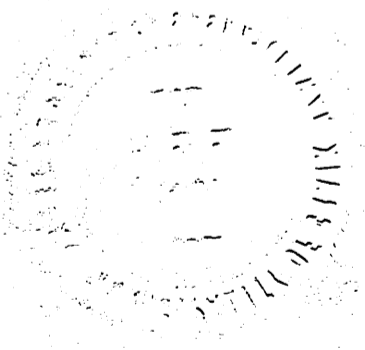
