

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF CRAIK NO. 222

BYLAW 95-03

A BYLAW TO CONTROL AND REGULATE THE USE OF THE CRAIK RESERVOIR BOAT LAUNCH AREA

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Craik No. 222 needs to control the use of the property owned and located on the (NE 23 24 28 W2nd Coft#64MJ07476);

AND WHEREAS Section 244(1)(h) of the Rural Municipality Act, 1989 provides the authority to control and regulate the use by the public of property owned or controlled by the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Section 206(2)(b) of the Rural Municipality Act, 1989 provides authority to preventing or restricting, controlling and regulating vehicles or of any class of vehicle;

NOW THEREFORE the Rural Municipality of Craik No. 222 hereby enacts as follows:

1. Interpretation

"Highway" means a road, parkway, driveway, square or place designed and intended for and used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, by does not include any provincial highway within the municipality as designated pursuant to the provisions of THE HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION ACT 1983-84 C.5,S.4,

"Parking" has the meaning ascribed thereto by THE HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT,

"Vehicle" means a vehicle, trailer, or semi-trailer or a motor vehicle as ascribed to it by THE HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT,

2. No person shall fish off any dock owned or controlled by the Rural Municipality of Craik No. 222 located on the NE 23 24 28 W 2nd

3. No. person shall park a vehicle in any "No parking" area as designated in Appendix "A" at any time whether such areas are marked on the curb or otherwise by signs erected and maintained in accordance with the provisions of section 4 to indicate that parking therein is prohibited.

4. Council shall cause to be erected and maintained at all "No Parking" areas listed in Appendix "A" appropriate signs and /or curb markings. Such signs or curb markings shall be visible from that part of the highway to which the restriction applies.

5. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
