Mail-in Ballot Voting

The RM Craik No. 222 has adopted Bylaw No. 2020-06 Mail-in Ballot Bylaw. Under this bylaw, ratepayers can sign up to vote for municipal elections using a mail-in ballot voting system.

Note: Any mail-in ballots received after the close of polls on Election Day (8:00 pm) on November 13th, 2024 are deemed to be spoiled, will remain unopened in the voter confirmation envelope and are given to the municipal administrator.

Complete Form R – Voters Registration form – Mail-in-Ballot and Form C - Declaration of person Requesting Mail-in-Ballot and submit these forms to the RM of Craik by:

- Dropping them off at the Municipal Office, located at 222 Grid 643
 Craik, SK
- Emailing to rm222@sasktel.net
- Mailing to PO Box 420 Craik, SK, S0G0V0.

Voters must also provide the necessary voter identification to prove his or her identity. A voter shall include one of the following to prove his or her identity.

- one piece of identification issued by the Government of Canada, the Government of Saskatchewan, a municipality or a government agency that contains a photograph of the voter and his or her name and address; or
- two pieces of information prescribed in the regulations, each of which establishes the voter's name and at least one of which establishes the voter's address.

You can register to vote by mail-in ballot up to November 12th (one day before the election day).

Upon receiving the completed Voter's Registration Form, Declaration of Person Requesting a Mail-In Ballot and the voter identification to prove his or her identity, RM staff will create a ballot kit. This ballot kit will include ballots, a Ballot Security Envelope, a Voter Confirmation Envelope, an Outer Envelope, directions to voters and a list of candidates who are seeking election. RM staff will mail the completed ballot kit to the address you provided.

After you have voted and completed all steps on the directions provided, submit the Outer Envelope to the RM by dropping it off at the Municipal Office or mailing it to the RM Office.

Please note that Schedule A and Schedule B require a signature by a witness. This witness may be either:

- 1. The returning officer;
- 2. The deputy returning officer;
- 3. The enumerator;
- 4. Any other person authorized to sign oaths; or
- 5. Any other person* (*including a member of the same household who is over the age of 18)
